Opening Ceremony

Just a reminder that we will have a ribbon cutting ceremony for the parking ramp at noon on Monday, November 23rd. You are invited to join us at the 2nd Street entrance for cookies and fresh hot apple cider. After the ribbon cutting ceremony, the ramp will be open for use.

Free Parking

I mentioned in the last update that parking would be free in the ramp until November 30th. **GOOD NEWS: Parking will now be free in the ramp until Monday, January 4th!** So come to Downtown Stillwater for your holiday shopping and celebrating, while you're here you can park free in the new ramp.

Purchase of Parking Ramp Passes

The sale of parking passes for the ramp will still begin Monday, November 23rd at 8:00 AM. But, you won't need to start using the passes until January 4th. They may be purchased at the reception desk at City Hall. For questions related to the passes, please call 651.430-8800.

Parking Ramp Rates

There are a variety of parking pass options, which you can see below. Besides the contract parking, transient parking will also be available. This will be at a flat rate of \$3 per day (\$5 per day on summer weekends). During special events such as Lumberjack Days and 4th of July fireworks, an event fee of \$10 will be charged.

Contract Parking Rates

Uncovered space (fourth level)	\$30/quarter
Covered space	\$45/quarter
Covered space, bulk rate (5 permits min.)	\$36/quarter/permit
Covered reserved space	\$60/quarter

How do the Gates Work?

When you drive up to the ramp entrance, either on 2nd Street or 3rd Street, the **ENTRANCE GATE** will **AUTOMATICALLY OPEN**. You do not need to show your parking pass upon entering. If you are a transient parking customer, no ticket will be dispensed when you enter the ramp. All parking **TRANSACTIONS** will occur **WHEN YOU EXIT**. This will either be by putting your pass up next to the pass reader, or by paying with cash or credit card. This might sound a bit confusing, but you'll have a month of free parking to check out how it all works. So, no need to fret!
